
Emitter Comparison



1. Field Rate refers to the number of video fields per second that the emitter is synchronized to. The Stereo Sync input signal is normally a square wave at half the field rate, i.e. for a 120 Hz field rate, the Stereo Sync signal would be a 60 Hz square wave.

2. Range information is based on the emitter's IR field. Actual eyewear range will be effected by eyewear sensitivity and viewing environment.
